SMARTFLOWER: Our two SmartFlower solar systems produce 9,000 kWh of energy annually. Over their lifetime, they will generate enough clean energy to offset the greenhouse gas emissions from 354,000 miles driven.

BIKE PARKING: Assembly Row was designed to enhance the health, productivity and quality of life of its community. Baxter Park is a big part of this effort with a biking/jogging path along the Mystic River, paired with ample bike parking throughout the project to help promote living a healthy lifestyle.



SOLAR PANELS: Combined, the project's 831 kW solar photovoltaics systems at three separate locations produce over 810,000 kWh of electricity annually which offsets over 1.2 million lbs. of CO2.



BLUEBIKES: Metro Boston's public bike share program boasts 1,800+ bikes at 200+ stations across Boston, Brookline, Cambridge, Somerville and Everett. Bikes can be unlocked from one station and returned to any other station in the system, making them ideal for one-way trips.



RIDE SHARE: Zipcar car sharing is availabe in the Block 4 Garage.



MONTAJE APARTMENTS: Montaje was the first residential tower in Somerville to achieve LEED GOLD certification. With 447 Luxury Units, Montaje offers residents covered bike parking, all LED lighting, as well as various sustainable design features.



ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS: Electrify America stations in Block 4 + Block 6 garages provide advanced DC fast charging, as well as traditional EV charging for the neighborhood. Additional charging stations are scattered thoughout the property.



BEST BEES: Assembly Row is home to two Italian honeybee colonies thanks to our partnership with Best Bees. Located on a green roof at The Row Hotel, the harvested honey is fused into the hotel's menu. The beehives are studied to help improve the health and safety of bees nationwide.



450 ARTISAN WAY: Our 100,000 sf building became the first Somerville office building to achieve LEED Gold status by incorporating sustainable construction techniques that include: EPDM roofing, enhanced insulation, recycled, regionally-sourced materials and certified wood.



PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION: Assembly Station, the first MBTA station on the orange line built since 1987, opened in 2014. The station was funded through a partnership between the state, federal agencies, and Federal Realty. The MBTA estimates that the \$57 million station will serve about 5,000 riders a day by 2030. The Assembly Station currently serves an estimated ridership of 1.2 million annually.



REMEDIATED BROWNFIELD: Prior to becoming Assembly Row, this site served as a Ford assembly plant, a steel factory and other industrial-centric uses over the years. Before construction could begin, Federal Realty had to make a significant investment in environmental remediation and infrastructure to serve the site, including the Mystic River cleanup.
